Dear SRA Judges, Officials and Competitors,

**Notice of Competition Requirements Amendments to (“SRA”) Rule Book (“Rule Book”)**

I refer to the above matter.

In accordance with Rule 2.6, the Ski Racing Australia (SRA) Board ratified an amendment to the SRA Rule Book (Rule Book) on Tuesday 12th December, 2017

The amendment/addition to the rules relates to the implementation of a speed cap for ALL Under 13 skiers at 70mph and ALL skiers Under the age 16 at 85mph. Furthermore the entire sport is speed capped to 120mph. Penalties will be applied for over-speeds as per Rule 8.11 (A)(B)(C)(D).

This affects Rule 8.3 (a)(ii) and (vi) detailed below.

**8.3 Competition Divisions, Age of Competitors, Maximum Boat Litres and Speed & Social Class Rules**

(a) Competition in each event may be separated into the following sections:-

(ii) Divisions

5 - 10 Years	Under 10 Boys and Girls. Speed is capped at 60mph and is in accordance with rule 8.11 (A).
10 - Under 13 Years	Sub-Junior Boys and Girls. Speed is capped at 70mph and is in accordance with rule 8.11 (B)
13 - Under 16 Years	Junior Boys and Girls. Speed is capped at 85mph in accordance with Rule 8.11 (C)

(vi) All classes to be capped at 120mph (excluding 60,70,85,90 & 100mph) and in accordance with Rule 8.11 (D)

This rule is effective immediately for season 2017/18.
